Who Should attend?

The Programme accommodates all levels of management across industry sectors in the private and public enterprises. Do I qualify?

How and when can I attend?

This is a 1 year intensive programme that is delivered through 4 classroom lectures of 4 days each.



The programme employs a diversity of teaching and learning methods including:

- Assignments (Group and Individual)
- Workplace Integrated Learning
