



## *What is it about?*

Praxis is a free framework for the management of projects, programmes and portfolios. It includes a body of knowledge, methodology, competency framework and capability maturity model. The framework is supported by a knowledgebase of resources and an encyclopaedia.

Praxis brings together a body of knowledge, methodology, competence framework and capability maturity model in a single integrated framework with a single structure and terminology.

The framework is designed to provide building blocks that can be tailored and assembled to suit all manner of different contexts.

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# Praxis® Foundation and Practitioner Course

## *Who Should attend?*

This Praxis certification is suitable for anyone interested in acquiring a basic understanding of the Praxis framework. ## *Do I qualify?*

## *How and when can I attend?*

This is an intensive 5 day course leading to the Praxis Foundation examination on the third day. The 1 hour closed-book examination consisting of 75 Questions and delegates must get 38 out of 75 which is (50%) to pass .

In order to acquire the Praxis Practitioner certification, delegates must have completed the Praxis Foundation training course and examination.

The Praxis Practitioner exam which takes place on the final day is a 2.5 hour scenario-based exam that consist of 4 Questions worth 20 marks each.

To pass the exam delegates will be required to obtain 40+ Marks from all questions which is (50%)
