Who Should attend?

This Praxis certification is suitable for anyone interested in acquiring a basic understanding of the Praxis framework. Those involved in the management of Projects, Programmes, and Portfolios may benefit from this training course including: Project Managers, General Managers, Programme Managers, Team Managers & Support Staff

Do I qualify?

Depending on experience, delegates are encouraged to devote at least 30-40 hours of pre-course studying before attending the course.

All delegates must have successfully completed the Praxis Foundation exam before moving on to the Praxis Practitioner exam.

How and when can I attend?

This is an intensive 5 day course leading to the Praxis Foundation examination on the third day. The 1 hour closed-book examination consisting of 75 Questions and delegates must get 38 out of 75 which is (50%) to pass.

In order to acquire the Praxis Practitioner certification, delegates must have completed the Praxis Foundation training course and examination.

The Praxis Practitioner exam which takes place on the final day is a 2.5 hour scenario-based exam that consist of 4 Questions worth 20 marks each.

To pass the exam delegates will be required to obtain 40+ Marks from all questions which is (50%)
