Who Should attend?

This specialized course is aimed at Project Engineers, Project Mangers, Project Planners, Project Controllers, Project Schedulers, Project Accountants, PMO Managers, Cost Controllers, Cost Estimators, Cost Engineers, Quantity Surveyors.

Do I qualify?

Delegates who wish to take the CCT certification exam must have:

- 4 years of industry related experience, or
- 4 years industry related degree
- Adherence to AACE's Canons of Ethics

How and when can I attend?

- 3 hours maximum
- 100 simple multiple choice questions
- Open Book using AACE's CCT Primer and S&K only (must be in a binder), plus any style, battery operated calculator permitted (not provided by the testing centre)

The Certified Cost Technician (CCT) certificate is valid for 3 years and is non renewable. The CCT course facilitates you to move forward to get certified as a Certified Cost Professional (CCP).
